Regardless of the number of credits transferred to Defiance College, transfer students must meet several residency requirements, including 1) 30 credit hours at Defiance College, 2) 15 hours in the major at Defiance College, and 3) 24 credits at the 300/400 level at a four-year college or university. Majors at Defiance College may have additional requirements (e.g. grade of C or better in each course in the major) that are posted in the University Catalog. This is subject to change without notice in the case of new courses being added by either College and if any articulation agreements are signed between the two Colleges.
